Vineyard Description:

Located in West Sonoma County, ten miles from the coast as the crow flies, this is the perfect location for Pinot Noir. This vineyard's soil composition is a rich Goldridge Sandy Loam.

Tasting Notes:

This Pinot Noir shows a vibrant, acid-driven profile with a crunchy texture, deep color, and expressive fruit. While not delicate, it is structured and energetic, balancing intensity with freshness. Designed as a food-focused wine, it pairs seamlessly with lighter, refined cuisine.
