## 2025 Rosé of Zinfandel Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County

<b>Varietal:</b>	100% Zinfandel
<b>Appellation:</b>	Dry Creek Valley
<b>Harvest:</b>	August 2025
<b>Fermentation:</b>	100% barrel fermented in neutral French Oak
<b>Alcohol:</b>	12.0%

### Winemaker's Notes:

Zinfandel's versatility as a varietal is on display in this intentional rosé. We pick these grapes at 20 Brix to capture its bright acidity and go direct to press with whole clusters. Utilizing 100% native yeast fermentation, this wine is all about varietal and terroir – and we happen to think the best Zinfandel in the world is grown in Dry Creek Valley.

### Vineyard Description:

Mizany Vineyard is a 16-acre certified organic vineyard planted in the famous Cortina Gravel of Dry Creek Valley. When planting the Zinfandel vineyard, we took a heritage approach and planted a field blend much like the first vineyards planted in the area. Our Zinfandel clone is the DuPratt clone on 1103 Paulsen root stalk.

### Tasting Notes:

This mouthwatering and refreshing wine is summer in a glass. With salt air breeze aromas, the palate explodes in underripe cherry with a hint of peach. Enticing aromas and flavors are backed by minerality, salinity and texture that make this a complex and balanced but totally crushable Rosé.
